Vineyard

Fruit for the 2015 Willamette Valley Pinot Noir is sourced from ten vineyards including Alloro, La Colina, Olson Estate, White Rose, Varga, and Winkler.

Vintage

Early bud-break after a dry and mild winter and spring. Harvest began September 12. Vines stayed green and healthy all through harvest despite lack of rainfall. September cooled allowing for greater flavor development. Clusters were plump and heavy with large berries and high overall vineyard yields.

Wine

Fruit is hand sorted and fermented without whole clusters for 13-19 days in 1.5 ton open fermenters.
Nine months barrel aging in French oak: 20% new, 14% year old, the rest neutral.

pH: 3.71

Total Acidity: 5.5 g/l

Alcohol: 13.15%

Residual sugar: .2 g/100 ml

Tasting Notes

Opens with aromas wild flowers and roses mixed with complex red and dark berries including cherries. Fresh acidity enhances the rich and complex fruity center. Finish is long with the complexity of fruit, juicy tannins and a hint of spice.
