2017 Pinot Blanc

Vineyard

Fruit for the 2017 Pinot Blanc was sourced from Winkler Vineyard located in the Yamhill Carlton AVA on the slopes of Mt. Richmond between 600-700 feet in elevation.

Vintage

Growing season began with late bud break following another very wet winter. Summer was hot and dry with record temperatures, with the exception of a cooler June. Like 2015 vineyard yields were on the higher side forcing growers to drop clusters in the vineyards.

Wine

Harvested October 8, this Pinot Blanc was pressed and racked into stainless steel tanks and neutral French oak barrels. Inoculated with D47 yeasts the wine is aged on lees without malo-lactic fermentation.

pH: 3.18

Total Acidity: 0.63 g/100 ml

Alcohol: 13.1%

Residual sugar: 0.2 g/100 ml

Tasting Notes

The 2017 Pinot Blanc offers bright and fresh floral aromas. The flavors have a bright acidity and richness, a mix of floral and citrus-green apple notes. Finish is long with a dry-mineral sensation. This Pinot Blanc is a great companion to seafood dishes.
