2020 PINOT NOIR ROSÉ



VINTAGE

The 2020 growing season started with an early to average budbreak before mid-April, following a mild and dry November-December with a wet January early February and a single snow event. Mid to end of February was warmer than average, by early April reaching the 70's. In early May the heat turned on with low 80s, reaching the 90s by the end of the month. June reset the clock with 2 cold and showery weeks, when bloom started, leading to poor pollination resulting in smaller berries and very loose clusters. Summer was very dry with forest fires in Southern Washington, Western and Southern Oregon, Northern California, including the Chehalem Mountains. The Northern Willamette Valley filled with heavy smoke for weeks at a time.

CELLAR

Harvested dates: October 2
Whole cluster pressing without skin contact
Fermentation: 27 days in small stainless-steel tanks
No malolactic fermentation

TASTING NOTES

The 2020 Torii Mor Rosé has a beautiful, brilliant light pink color with a forward-sweet aroma and a mix of strawberries and fresh roses. The flavors show a refreshing acidity with juicy strawberries and a touch of crème brûlée. The mouthfeel is bright with texture and a long juicy finish. This Rosé is ready to be enjoyed now.
